## School Comms



Parental engagement and communication is extremely important to us.

At City Academy Norwich the Academy we use the School Gateway app for all communication, either via email or text. This way our parents and carers are kept up-to-date with the latest information.

As well as communication you can do the following:

Make payments for trips and visits, music lessons, food tech subs, art books and lockers

#### How to activate your account

- Download the Schoolgateway app on an Android or iPhone
- Press 'New User' then enter the email and mobile the Academy has on record.
- Press 'Send PIN'. You will then receive a text message with your unique PIN.
- You are now ready to log in and start using School Gateway

NOTE: if you don't get a PIN, it's likely the Academy doesn't have the right email and/or phone number on our records - please get in touch with our office to check.

## Meals

To pay for your child's meal you need to be signed up to our School Comms app (Gateway) details on previous page.

When your child joins us in September they will have their biometric fingerprint taken (if you have given consent) which will enable them to pay for food. Students in receipt of free school meals will have their account automatically credited with the allocated amount each day.

Our catering company, **ASPENS**, offers a varied menu with options for both hot and cold food. Each day there is a choice of a meal deal for £2.53 Vegetarian and vegan options are available.

## **Behaviour for Learning Expectations**

#### Students are expected to:

- conduct themselves around the building in a safe, sensible, manner and show regard to others
- arrive on time to lessons
- bring equipment appropriate for the lesson
- follow reasonable instructions given by the teacher
- behave in a reasonable and polite manner to all staff and students
- show respect for the opinions and beliefs of others
- complete all class work in the manner required
- hand in homework at the time requested
- show respect for the school environment
- follow the student expectations

#### Sanctions for disruptive behaviour

#### REMIND - C1 – a verbal Reminder

The teacher will remind student of our expectations and give them an opportunity to make the correct choice.

#### WARNING - C2 – first recorded warning

The teacher will repeat the reminder and warn you that continued poor choices will result in you being removed from the room. The teacher may use several strategies to support the student in making improved behaviour choices.

REMOVE - C3 – final recorded warning and removed from classroom. Should the student behaviour continue to fall below our expectations, they will be removed from the classroom and go straight to the Remove Room.

This will result in a 20-minute lunchtime or after school detention, depending on the time of day.

#### **Mobile phones**

The use of mobile phones in school is NOT ALLOWED

Students can have their mobile phones with them, but they MUST be turned off and kept in their bags/lockers/pockets.

If a student has their phone out it will be confiscated and taken to the SLT office, when it can be picked up by the student at the end of the day. If they have received a detention at the end of the day, they can collect once detention is completed.

## Rewards

Rewards are used to recognise all positive contributions to the academy. They include giving House points, sending home postcards, Headteacher's certificates, Celebration assemblies and every term there is a rewards based activity.

The criteria for the rewards based activity always includes a positive attitude to attendance, behaviour and contribution to the wider life of the academy.

The purpose is to encourage further positive behaviours.
